Ahmed Fahmy obtained his B.Sc. from the Faculty of Engineering, Cairo University in civil engineering in 1965. He has a higher diploma in hydraulics, hydrology, and irrigation.

Mr Fahmy is a member of the United Nations Economic and Social Commission for western Asia, Inter-Islamic Network on Water Resources Development & Management, and also the Arab Water Council.

He is currently a consultant to Nile Water Sector, Ministry of Water Resources and Irrigation, Egypt. Mr Fahmy has conducted several consultancy services to different national and international agencies. He was previously Director General in the Minister's technical office.

Mr Fahmy spent about 12 years working in different Nile Basin countries dealing with the Nile issues starting as a junior and then as a senior hydrologist, and moving on to be a director of the HYDROMET project in Uganda.

He participated in the development of the mathematical model of upper Nile, as well as in the calibration and running of the mathematical model of Lake Plateau.

Mr Fahmy has interest and has participated in issues related to hydrological aspects in developing the Egypt Master Plan.
