The one-day workshop forms part of the activities at the Singapore International Water Week and is to encourage scientific enquiry and interaction amongst young, budding scientists and engineers in the water industry. By linking of the workshop and the main SIWW conference, these young researchers benefit from exposure to renowned international researchers and key industrial water players. At the same time, industry will have the opportunity to talent scout and recruit skilled manpower.

Symposium Topics

The Symposium will focus primarily on the technical aspects of water science and technology, with topics including:

- **Biotechnology**
- **Advanced treatment technologies**
- **Water quality analytics**
- **Water resources management**
- **Aquatic sciences**

Papers can be submitted for either Oral or Poster presentation. Submission of an Extended Abstract, limited to five A4 pages (including figures and tables, Arial font, size 10, single spacing) with adequate information to allow a sound technical review is required. - Authors' name and affiliation
- Email address, postal address, telephone and fax numbers

Symposium Costs
