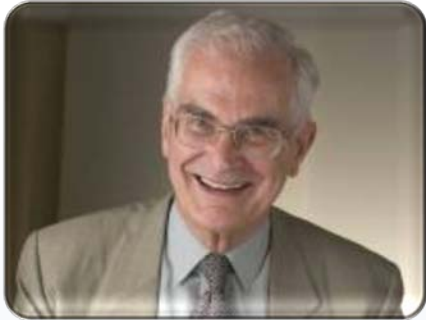


WATER LEADERS SUMMIT – ROUNDTABLE 2

Ron Oxburgh (Lord Oxburgh of Liverpool) trained as a geologist/geophysicist (Oxford & Princeton). He subsequently taught and researched in those disciplines at Oxford, Cambridge, Stanford and Caltech. After seven years as President of Queens' College Cambridge, he became Chief Scientific Adviser to the Ministry of Defence (1987 – 1993). From 1993 to 2001 he served as Rector of Imperial College. 2004 to 2005, he served as Chairman of Shell. He is a Fellow of the Royal Society and Royal Academy of Engineering and a Foreign Member of the US Academy of Sciences. He is currently President of the Carbon Capture and Storage Association and advises the Government of Singapore in the fields of energy, environment and higher education.
