He has served as a consultant to national and international government and business organizations and is currently a member of the Louisiana Governor's commission on coastal protection, co-chair of the World Water Assessment Programme's Expert Policy Group, and was recently appointed by The Secretary of State as one of three inaugural Energy and Climate Partnership of the Americas Fellows.

He was Presidential appointee to the Mississippi River Commission and was assigned to the White House to lead a study of the 1993 Mississippi River Flood. He served in the US Army for 38 years retiring as a Brigadier General. He is a member of the National Academy of Engineering and a Fellow of the National Academy of Public Administration.
