She was the UN Special Ambassador for MDGs in Asia Pacific, the Indonesian Minister of Human Settlements and Regional Development; member of the Commission on Developing Countries and Global Changes, and Commission on Legal Empowerment of the Poor.

Erna is at present the Chairperson of Asia Pacific Philanthropy Consortium (APPC) based in Manila, and the Foundation for Local Governance Innovation (YIPD). She is on the board of diverse Indonesian CSOs like the the Foundation for Sustainable Development (YPB), the Indonesian Biodiversity Foundation (KEHATI), etc; also on international CSOs like the International Institute for Sustainable Development (IISD) and Earth Charter International.

Ms. Witoelar graduated in Chemical Engineering from Bandung Institute of Technology in 1974, and completed her post-graduate study in Human Ecology from the University of Indonesia in 1993.
